STR SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

At St Raphael's Catholic Primary School, the students take pride in wearing their school uniform. When choosing to send your child to St Raphael's, you accept that your children will follow the School Uniform Policy. You are asked to cooperate with the policy and understand that without reasonable excuse, students will be disciplined for breaches of the uniform code.

Uniform Suppliers

All items of St Raphael's uniform except school bags and hats are available at Lowes Hurstville - 276 Forest Rd, Hurstville NSW 2220 or <u>online</u>. School bags, library bags, and hats are available from the school office.

The school runs a second-hand uniform shop, where all items are priced between \$2 and \$5.

Labelling Belongings

School clothing can be expensive and is often lost or misplaced. To avoid this situation, parents are requested to mark **all** removable uniform items with the child's name and class. A periodic check by you will ensure that the labelling is legible.

General Uniform Requirements

- Shoulder length/long hair is to be tied back for health and safety reasons
- No jewellery is to be worn except a watch and earrings (one sleeper or stud per ear)
- The wearing of nail polish and/or makeup is not allowed.
- Hair to be neat and tidy -No razor lines or undercut
- All shoulder-length hair is to be tied back off the shoulder with a blue or white hair tie or the school scrunchie.

Lost Property Bin

This is located in the office area. It is emptied and distributed each term. Items
not claimed are disposed of at the end of each term. Parents are free to check for
missing items. Please ensure all uniform items are marked with the child's name,
as well as plastic storage containers and lunch boxes.

- ~ Shorts or Tracksuit navy track pants to match jacket (navy/white microfibre with school emblem)
- ~ White ankle socks
- ~ Runner <u>predominantly white, no fluoro colours</u>

School Shoe

Formal leather school shoe

OR

School-friendly leather style shoe

- durable <u>full</u> leather look design (fully black) that resembles an activity shoe but maintains a neat, structured and polished appearance. **No fabric type material or white sole**
- No vibrant patterns, logos or contrasting colours

Sports Shoe

• Predominately white sports running shoe - no bright colours



Procedure to follow up on a uniform breach

- 1. Students with a valid reason for not wearing the school uniform are asked to communicate this to their class teacher via a note from their parents. If students do not have a note, they are asked to bring one the next day.
- 2. If the student still has the uniform breach the next day and does not have a note, they will receive a uniform breach recorded as a Chronicle on Compass by the class teacher. The chronicle will be communicated to the parents via an email asking parents to rectify the breach as soon as possible or state when the breach will be rectified.
- 3. The class teacher is to follow up with the parent if they have not rectified the breach within one week.
